Еще до «Российского Вертера...», в 1792 г., стихотворение «Жизнь» было помещено без подписи в журнале «Дело от безделья», где печатался Сушков. При общей смысловой тональности, оно отличается от приведенного выше. Можно предположить, что это его вариант:

Что наша жизнь есть? Бурно море,
 Исполненное волн и бед.
 С начала дней мы терним горе,
 До смерти нам покоя нет.
 Родимся — плачем и рыдаем...
 На свете сем все переменю
 И скорогиблюще и тленно,
 Как сон, как тень, как пыль, как прах...

Тут же звучит характерный для Сушкова естественно-эгалитарный мотив:

И ница, и царя народа
 Премудрая во всем природа
 Сравнила одного с другим,
 Дабы владетель не гордился,
 Что он повелевать родился:
 Он может быть и сим и им!

Далее следует столь же присущее Сушкову обличение своскорыстия и эгоцентризма новоявленных хозяев жизни:

Вот богачи! Как Мидас с Крезом
 Обильны алатом и серебром!
 Дамаск беднее их железом;
 Однако ж думают о том,
 Чтобы доход свой приумножить:
 Их честь и совесть не тревожит,
 Что страждут ближние в беде,
 Они о том не рассуждают
 И алата столько же жаждают,
 Как Тантал пить, быв весь в воде [3, с. 26—29].
